DAISY THE DINOSAUR

BEE-BOT

A very cool app for making an audio podcast (no video, no graphics, just audio)

SPREAKER

A wonderful MS/HS Math App that every math teacher must explore

KHAN ACADEMY

A cool lower school app that allows 2-4 kids to use one iPad and be quizzed by random questions that you make up yourself or use from the company (e.g. matching animals and words)

FUTABA

A powerful MS/HS Math Graphing App and Web site that includes SLIDERS so that you can change A, B, C in an equation such as $Y = Ax^2 + Bx + C$ and students can see the effect

DESMOS

A foreign language drill/practice app that many teachers and students love.

DUOLING

A cool app that lets you make your own "online magazine" out of links to articles.

FLIPBOARD

A world atlas app that seems to charm everyone who sees it.

BAREFOOT WORLD ATLAS

A Spanish App that people seem to like a lot

MIRAI SPANISH

An app that allows you to "control" all the iPads in the class and display one screen at a time on each of the iPads in your class.
