Alexander Montessori School (2) (6050 SW 57th Ave Miami, FL)	" Nestled on four scenic campuses in Miami-Dade County, Alexander Montessori School holds a reputation as one of the world's leading Montessori schools. Founded in 1963 by Beverly McGhee, this independent day school remains the only fully-accredited American Montessori School in Miami."
Brooklyn Charter School (545 Willoughby Ave)	" Brooklyn Charter School is an elementary school serving approximately 246 students from kindergarten through fifth grade in the 2011-2012 school year. Last year, 95% of parents attended parent-teacher conferences, and the school boasted an attendance rate of 92 percent."
Hewitt School (45 East 75th Street, Manhattan)	"The Hewitt School is a college preparatory school for girls in kindergarten through grade twelve, founded in 1920. The school is located in Manhattan, near Central Park and the Museum Mile, and draws students from the tri-state area. At present, there are 525 students enrolled with a student-teacher ratio of 6.5:1."
Horace Mann School (3) (231 W 246 St, Bronx)	" 1816 students in Nursery through Twelfth Grades, 240 faculty members, Nursery School in Manhattan, 18 acre campus in Riverdale, Bronx. Founded in 1887 as a coeducational experimental and developmental unit of Teachers College, Columbia University. In 1947, it became an independent day school for boys in grades seven through twelve."
Mandell School (795 Columbus Ave, Manhattan)	" The Mandell School was founded in 1939 by Max Mandell, a pioneer in early childhood education. There are 253 students in Pre School and 238 in Elementary Division. The school is K-8 and the current head is the granddaughter of the founder."
Riverdale Country School (5250 Fieldston Road, Bronx)	" Riverdale Country School is an independent day school that provides a continuous coeducational program for boys and girls from pre-kindergarten through grade twelve. The school is located on two wooded campuses in the northwest corner of New York City, NY."
St. Luke's School (487 Hudson St, Manhattan)	" St. Luke's School is a coeducational Episcopal day school with 230 students of all faiths from Junior Kindergarten through Grade 8. Founded in 1945, St. Luke's offers a balanced and challenging curriculum that serves intellectually curious and able students in a small, intimate learning environment."
Staten Island Community Charter School (309 St. Paul's Ave)	" Staten Island Community Charter School (SICCS) prepares K-8 students in New York City School District 31 to excel in college preparatory high schools. Staten Island Community Charter School (SICCS) was founded by parents, grandparents and educators from the neighborhoods of Staten Island's North Shore."
The Town School (2) (540 East 76th Street, Manhattan)	" The Town School is committed to elementary co-education, serving students in nursery through eighth grade. Town's program balances the traditional and the innovative, emphasizing excellence in academics and a thorough exposure to the arts and physical education. Town was founded in 1913."
